

From the Pastor's Desk

As you may remember, last year Bishop Johnston initiated a Diocesan Visioning Process to set a course for the diocese for the foreseeable future. Many of you attended one (or more) of the listening sessions last summer, and perhaps you had the opportunity to express your own hopes for the Vision of our diocesan Church. This month, the Bishop and his Visioning Team have begun rolling out the outline for this vision with a philosophy and concrete action steps for us to take as a Church for the coming years. You will no doubt read more about it in the coming edition of the Catholic Key and in the letter which the Bishop has sent to each registered household in the diocese. In particular, I would like to draw your attention to the fact that the Bishop has called for a diocesan *Holy Year of Renewal* to begin on Ash Wednesday, March 6, 2019. Since this begins in just a few short weeks, I want you to have the opportunity to at least take part in some of the events which will be offered during this year of Grace, especially in the next few months:
