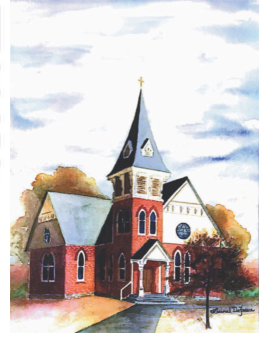

FROM FATHER DREW LAMB'S FEAST HYMN

Friends, last week I cited St Gaudentius of Brescia, an Italian bishop, d.410 AD, who elegantly wrote on the Eternal Sacrifice. Below is a beautiful hymn by St Nicetas of Remesiana (Serbia) who died in 414 AD. Note the sacrificial wording and that the Eucharist is no mere symbol. More evidence for us that the early Church was Catholic.

THE LAMB'S HIGH BANQUET WE AWAIT

As we await the Lamb's high feast
in snow-white robes of saving grace,
we sing to Christ, our Prince and Head,
for we have crossed the Red Sea tide.

His holy Body, parched and seared
upon the altar of the Cross,
his crimson Blood, outpoured for us,
we taste and so we live for God.

Protected on the paschal eve
from devastating angel sword,
we were delivered and set free
from Pharaoh's harsh and bitter rule.

And now, our Pasch is Christ himself,
the pure and spotless Lamb once slain,
unleavened bread of truthfulness,
who gives his flesh in sacrifice.

O worthy Victim, real and true,
who rends and breaks the pow'r of hell,
the captives there have been redeemed
and now enjoy the prize of life.

Christ rises from the tomb indeed,
triumphant Victor from the depths,
who thrusts the tyrant down in chains
and clears the way to Paradise.

O Jesus, be for mind and heart
our everlasting paschal joy
and gather us, reborn by grace,
to share your triumphs evermore.

To you, Lord Jesus, glory be,
who shine in vict'ry over death,
with God the Father, ever blest,
and loving Spirit, ever one. Amen.
