## FROM FATHER FENLON 4TH OF JULY MESSAGE - 1<sup>ST</sup> WEEK AT THE PARISH

It is with a fine irony that our Lord has designated this 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend to be the one in which I, an Englishman, commence my role as parish priest in the most American of small towns – Plattsburg, Missouri.

Wherein I do hereby promise NOT to attempt to take back any of the former colonies of His Majesty the King. Fear not! You have won your independence fair and square, with a little help from the French, and I too want to celebrate with you. We must not listen to the wounded and pernicious voices that tell us to hate our country, our identity, our beliefs. No! We will be unable to do anything if we do not hold firm to our beliefs, love who we are, and be grateful for the country that has nourished and nurtured us. So celebrate, and celebrate big (you do things BIG over here!). You are loved and cherished by God – you have a lot to celebrate.

My vocation, as your priest, is to communicate that love of God to you, and communicate to Him, in my prayer at the Altar, your sorrows and desires. I hope to be a father to St. Ann's. So it is with a fatherly, heavy, heart that I must inform you, with the change in assignments, Mass times have to change too.

Based on how my assignment is written, this is unavoidable. It was not part of my plan to do something like this, and I am genuinely sorry to have to ask this sacrifice of you, effectively, before even starting. My assignment to Plattsburg also asks me to assist at Spanish language Masses in St. Joseph, which occur on Wednesday evenings and Sunday mornings.

For that reason, Wednesday evening Mass cannot continue as it has up until now. I insist that Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will continue. I will now be offering **Confessions from 6pm to 8pm on Tuesdays** too.

Sunday Mass will also have to move to an earlier time – for now, it will be at **9:00am**.

Please talk to me about how these changes impact you, and any concerns you have. I want to hear your voice and communicate well. I want to be a spiritual father to you!

Please also, contact me if you like to attend daily Mass – I want to hear from you as I figure out a schedule for that.

I am sure that our Lord holds many graces - for all of us – in this coming stage of our lives. I look forward to getting to know you, His flock, over the coming weeks, months, years, (even decades?) and I am truly grateful to be your priest.
