
## CAMPAIGN PLEDGES

Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy New Year! On the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, we celebrate the Lord's Divinity through His Most Blessed Mother. Also called the Octave of Christmas and formerly the Feast of the

Circumcision of the Lord, this day gives us an opportunity to meditate upon the name of Jesus–God saves. Because the Word of God (the Son) is eternal and not made, He is God. This Word, God's Son, takes on human flesh in the womb of the Blessed Virgin. For this reason, she is afforded the title "Mother of God." He is the Son of God in her very womb! He is the Son of God when He is born and He is the Son of God after. There is not a moment where Jesus "becomes the Son of God." He is from His conception. Eight days after the birth of the Lord, He is circumcised according to the Mosaic Law. Not only is this a foreshadowing of what He has come to do (shed His Blood for us on the cross), but He receives His name—Jesus.

On Sunday, January 1st after the 10am Mass, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament and have the opportunity to sing together the hymn Veni Creator Spiritus which invokes the Holy Spirit upon us for a new year of grace. Participating in singing this hymn affords us a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions.
