Dear Friends in Christ-

We return to the second
theme of the Lord’s
Epiphany or manifestation of
His Divinity this Second
Sunday in Time through the
Year. Although we don’t
directly hear about the
baptism of Christ, the second of the three Epiphany
mysteries, we nevertheless encounter St. John the
Baptist once again who calls Jesus by a specific title,
“The Lamb of God.” We also hear St. Andrew
confess Jesus’ Messiahship. Both of these titles,
Lamb of God and Messiah, refer to the Divinity of
Christ which is hidden beneath His human
appearance. Roman Guardini, one of the great
commentators on the liturgy in the 20th century,
once quipped that we are more ready and willing to
believe in reality the trees that we see in nature with
our eyes than God Himself who created them. When
we encounter the Messiah and the Lamb of God
today, we say silently in the temple of our hearts,
truly this is the Son of God!

Many blessings for a new year filled with grace!

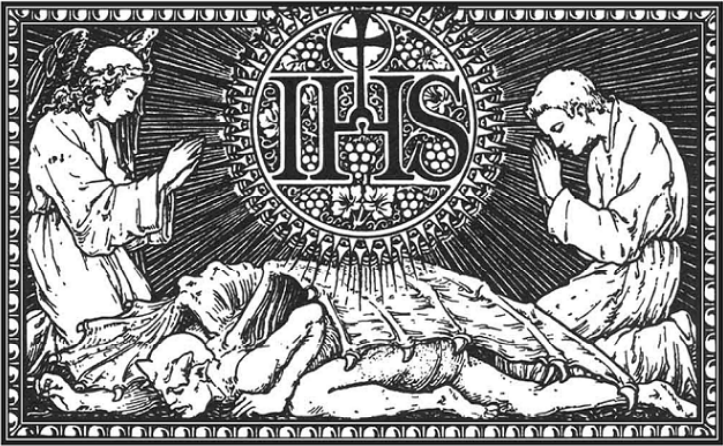
