On Thursday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7pm, we will close the Forty Days of Christmas with a special Candlemas Mass wherein candles will be blessed which represent Christ as the Light of the World and distributed for home use. We will process around the church building (weather permitting) and then will have Mass. The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord or the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary caps the Christmas cycle as Our Lady made her way to the Temple forty days after the Birth of the Lord according to Mosaic Law.

### Dear Friends in Christ,

When the Lord comes to choose Simon and Andrew and asks them to follow Him, St. John's Gospel already has Andrew meeting the Lord. In Matthew's version, we may surmise that Andrew might have known the Savior's voice. Perhaps Andrew already told his brother, Simon? Either way, with one command of the voice of the Savior, the brothers drop their nets and follow Him. In other words, they leave their former way of life behind initially with no planning, promises, or a million questions about "how this is going to work." They simply hear God speaking to them and trust the command.

In our own spiritual lives, I do believe that we choose sin, death and self-destruction over a lack of trust in God's Providence for us. We choose what looks good at the time, inaction on something that we could do, apathy or whatever it is out of a fear that God is going to call us and then abandon us. This mode of thinking can be us taking events, people and places in our lives and projecting them onto God Himself. We may ask, "Why does God allow this or that to take place?" After all, God is not a battery that emanates energy, but a person. Regardless of our circumstances, what would it mean to be caught off guard by this curious and inviting voice? The voice of God Himself? He doesn't ask anything detailed or overly complicated. He simply asks the Apostles to "follow Him." They don't know the fullness of what He asks. Love implies trust and not a calculated planning session of one's life. The Apostles intuited this Divine Presence and literally cast their lives out into the deep with the Master. If Jesus asks us to follow Him, what will we say? The Apostles had no words at the bidding of the Savior. They just left it all behind. Let us pray for this amount of trust in God's Divine Providence where we fail to see Him working in our lives.
