

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 2ND, 2022 7:00PM

On Thursday, February 2nd at 7pm, we will close the Forty Days of Christmas with a special Candlemas Mass wherein candles will be blessed which represent Christ as the Light of the World and distributed for home use. We will process around the church building (weather permitting) and then will have Mass. The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord or the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary caps the Christmas cycle as Our Lady made her way to the Temple forty days after the Birth of the Lord according to Mosaic Law.

Dear Friends in Christ,
This weekend we get to hear the Beatitudes from Matthew’s Gospel. Jesus climbs the mountain and is seated as the New Moses to give us the fulfillment of the Ten Commandments. While Our Lord doesn’t cancel the Ten Commandments in any way (we still have to follow them as moral precepts to

make us virtuous), He gives us a new understanding to make us saints or holy ones in the sight of the Father. In fact, this is the Gospel reading for All Saints day. Our Lord tells us how the Kingdom of Heaven is. Whenever we feel stuck in this “valley of tears,” we must remember the perseverance that the Lord enjoins on us by our hearing of this text. We may indeed be persecuted for the sake of righteousness or for believing in His name. We will certainly be tempted to be mighty, prideful, grab what we think is owed to us. Our Lord reminds us that justice and mercy in our time do not work this way. The Beatitudes teach us the virtue of long-suffering, patience and magnanimity. Pusillanimity or pettiness of soul has no room in the Kingdom of God. To be a saint in our times, we must heed the words of Christ who desires us to see the Father.
