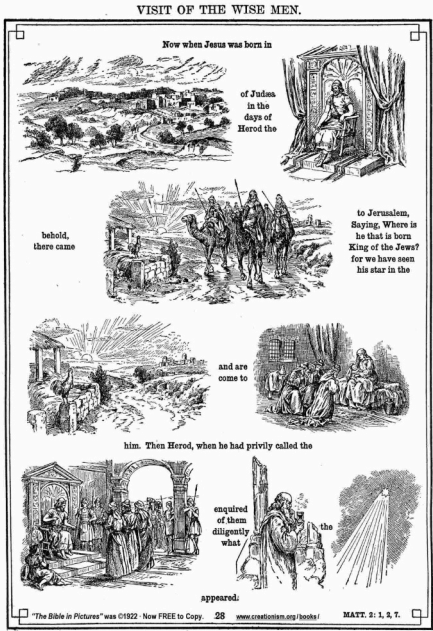

basket. Thank you!

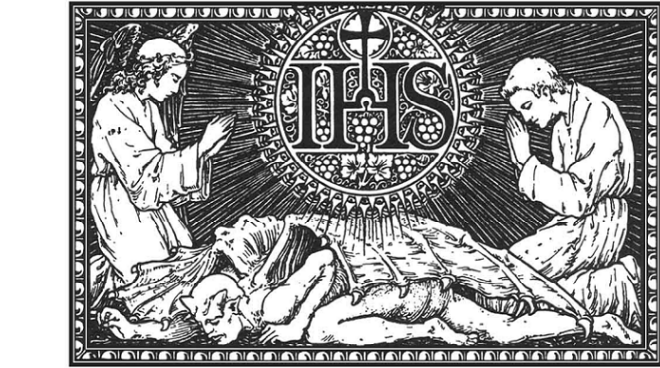




Dear Friends in Christ-
