Dear Friends in Christ,

As we celebrate the External Solemnity of the Epiphany this Sunday, we concentrate on not only the Three Kings and their gifts that they bring the Infant King, but also on the manifestation of Our Lord's Divinity. Our Lord manifests that He is God in three principal and

traditional ways—by receiving these gifts from the Magi, by sanctifying the waters of the Jordan in His Baptism for our salvation, and by performing His first "sign" or miracle in the Gospel of John at the Wedding of Cana. In our Latin Rite Western tradition, we typically focus more on the Magi and have spread out the Gospel themes for the other two portions of the mystery on other Sundays. In the Byzantine tradition, there is more of a focus on water being made sacred by the Lord's baptism. We have imported this blessing of water in the West for Epiphany (there is some in the back of the church for your use).

Regardless of what portion of the mystery the Church is accentuating, what is clear is that we need a reminder of Who Christ is—Jesus of Nazareth, born on Christmas, is Divine; He is the Son of God. He is the Splendor of the Father made flesh. St. Leo the Great writes in his homily for Epiphany that the Magi adored the Infant in swaddling clothes while we adore the Lord with our hearts in His omnipotence. May the strength of the Infant King and the peace of His government reign in our hearts as we worship Him at His altar.
