

Dear Friends in Christ,
St. Paul asks us to “complete his joy” by being of one mind and one heart. What does this mean? To have a divided heart means that what we know to be true is not consequent with what we’re doing. When there is an internal dissonance, there is disorder.

This is brought about by sin. To literally put on Christ means that we have a different attitude. Our wills and our minds are fixed upon Him Who is the Truth. To be of one mind and heart amongst one another cannot be accomplished on our own volition. Instead, we need to put on Christ. There is no true fraternity without Christ in the middle, without supernatural charity as our end. When we are thinking of the “one thing” which means that we look out towards God and not in towards self, charity will transform our selfishness and the self-serving movements of our hearts into self-gift.

ANNOUNCEMENT:
This year, Bishop Johnston has decided to change the way the Annual Catholic Appeal is accomplished. Last year, the diocese did not meet its goal. This year, all parishes will have a goal given to them. If the parish does not meet the goal, the remaining amount will be assessed. If the parish exceeds the set goal, the parish can keep 50% assessment free of the remainder. I know from experience that the parishes of registration are not accurate in diocesan records. This year, it is absolutely paramount that when you give to the Annual Catholic Appeal, you check the envelope to ensure that it says, “St. Ann, Plattsburg.” If you were registered elsewhere in the past, you may still be giving to that parish’s ACA goal. Because we are in danger of being assessed should we not make our goal, it is of absolute importance that we make sure the envelope that we use says our parish’s name on it. It makes a difference, because I don’t want us to have to pay at the end of the fiscal year if we have met our goal, but because of inaccuracies, we didn’t get credit. If you are unsure of your envelope, we have envelopes in the church that are labeled with our parish’s name on it. I would almost prefer (just to make absolutely sure) that you use one of these. In the coming weeks, they will be available in our pews.
