*Dear Friends In Christ,*

The parable of the dishonest judge teaches us to not put our own disappointments from our human interactions onto God. Indeed, when we are given into despair or a loss of hope over another's treatment of us, we can be tempted to project our experience onto God Himself. The point of today's parable is that God is just. If a dishonest man be just for simply irritated and selfish reasons, we would know that God is precisely the opposite of that; God actually loves justice. The Lord then moves this parable about justice and hope to the topic of Faith. When Jesus returns in glory to judge the living and the dead, will He find us reduced to believing only in our own abilities? In other words, will we have totally given up? Or will He find us with Faith, waiting for His coming, believing in the words that He has spoken? Let us place our Hope and Faith in God Himself and not ourselves. Unlike the unjust judge and more like the widow, we are persistent with God as we depend upon Him.
