

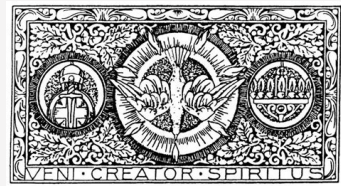

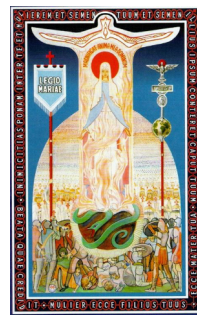

Dear Friends in Christ,

Whenever we try to give God an ultimatum, He surprises us with an answer that typically is neither of the two answers that we have proposed. “If you do this, I will do that.” God doesn’t deal in ultimatums. We see this especially in the questions proposed to the Lord today in the Gospel about whether or not to pay Caesar who represents the civil authority. The Lord in His infinite wisdom, outsmarts the Pharisees who try and trick Him with their malice. They were looking for a political Messiah to start a revolution. Jesus is not a revolutionary. Any power that Caesar has, even if Caesar is abusing it, has its origin in God. This is why Jesus can have the discourse He does with Pilate before His crucifixion and death. God is King over all. Christ is the cornerstone of any healthy society, even in the midst of petty despots. Such an easy question borne out of malice ends up giving us the truth of the matter—what we render to God is all things first for He has dominion and power over all. It is a false dichotomy to think otherwise. God is King.

This weekend, we have the opportunity to listen to Bishop Johnston’s words on the Annual Catholic Appeal. As I have stated before, please check your envelope that you have received in the mail to ensure that it says St. Ann Plattsburg on it. If it does not, or if you are unsure, please use the envelopes in the back of the church. As a bonus this year, we can keep 50% of whatever we give over the stated amount. Thank you for your participation and generosity.
