Dear Friends In Christ,

This Sunday’s readings cause us to reflect on our own individual places in the scheme of salvation and in the family of the Church. Are our roles merely perfunctory? I fast on the appointed days, I do this or that thing. It’s like reading a modern Catholic obituary— “Mrs. Smith was a Eucharistic minister and a lector.” Or “I went to (name the number) this many years of Catholic School, therefore, this certifies me as...(fill in the blank). “My father built this place! Therefore...fill in the blank. That’s the modicum of holiness! There it is! I fasted, I paid, I attended, I, I, I. And what many times follows, “I haven’t been to confession in 25 years. I don’t do anything wrong.” “God and I have this figured out.” I don’t need to bow my head in front of God anymore. I have no sin.

This is the sort of self-referential Phariseeism that the Lord is talking about. It is not enough to belong, to have a label, to check a box, the Lord desires a contrite heart. That is why the Publican, hated as he would’ve been by the establishment and rightly so, was more in the right for beating his breast before the presence of God. At least he was honest. He knew who he was in the sight of God. That is worth a whole lot more than any position, club, title, or activity. To really come to God and say, “These are my faults. Heal me. I cannot do it on my own.” This is what God honors. Lord Jesus, You are God. I am not.
