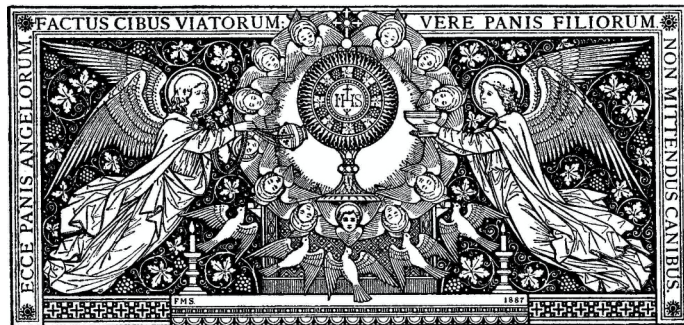

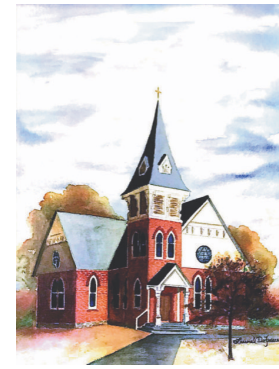

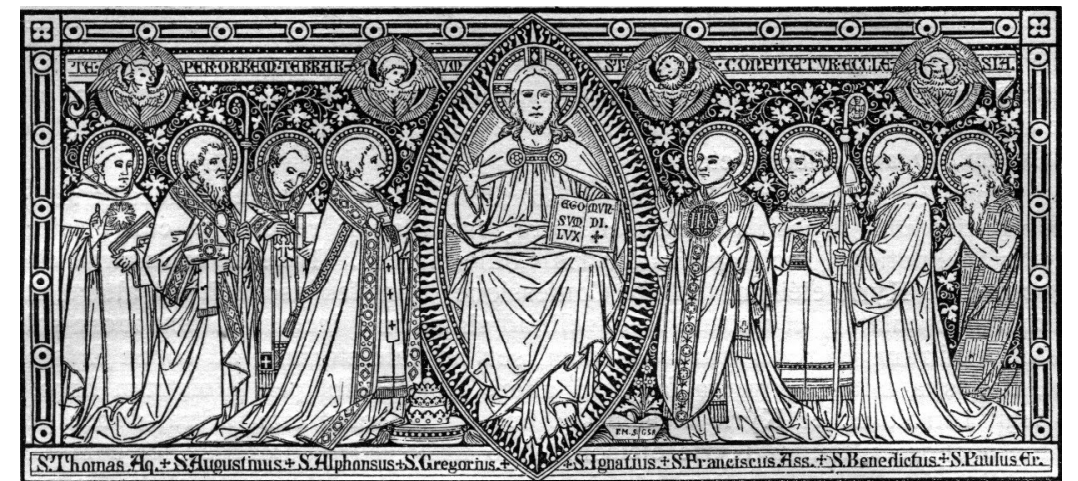

Dear Friends In Christ,

Traditionally, this is the text for the Dedication of a Church because “salvation” comes to the house of Zacchaeus. Yeshua or Jesus means “God Saves.” Literally, then, it is not in an analogous way that salvation comes to the house of a sinner, but in a real and abiding way. Jericho is an unpleasant place to pass through, yet Our Lord stops in the dirtiest of places to bring one sinner back to the Father. It is no different when the Presence of God visits each of our altars in a real and abiding way at every Holy Mass and when we are properly disposed, our own souls and bodies. Let us welcome the Lord into our interior homes, come down from the tree of shame, and greet Him!

As a reminder, All Saints Day is November 1st. It is a Holy Day of Obligation.
