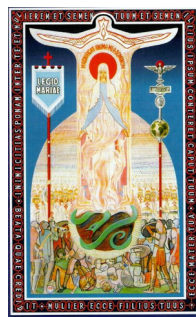

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Psalmist today writes to us that the “vineyard of the Lord is the House of Israel.” This has been fulfilled radically by the Lord Jesus Himself who invites us to be a part of His Vineyard and to partake of its fruits. As in ancient Israel, the House of Judah did not heed the Lord’s invitation. And in the Gospel, when the landowner sends his son, as he had sent so many before, those who have trashed the vineyard and murdered his other messengers, kill the son. In other words, they reject the cornerstone who is Christ after rejecting all of the prophets. God doesn’t change and either does His Divine Revelation. The same God of Israel, the same Jesus Christ speaks to us in the Mystical Body today. We must receive His invitation as His tenants. None of us has the ability to “change” what is offered to us based on our times or our personal circumstances. To do so would be rise in revolt as the tenants did in today’s parable. We are to lovingly cultivate His Word in our lives. The possession of the Kingdom of God which the landowner gives to us is not a right, but a privilege that is given when fruit is produced. Let us heed the warning of both Isaiah and the Lord Himself to hear the word of God, to cultivate it, and to produce fruit that will last.
