Dear Friends In Christ,

What does it mean to be cleansed? In both the sacrament of Baptism and in the sacrament of Penance, which can be a like a new baptism, we are healed and made whole again from the leprosy of our sins. Naaman the Syrian thought it ridiculous to go and wash in the pool at first. Today, even many Catholics may find it ridiculous that something as simple as confessing one's sins can actually cleanse us spiritually. Yet, Jesus

Christ tells us differently. He gives the power to His bishops (Apostles) and priests to act in His name. Look at Naaman the Syrian. What is his response to being cleansed? He will no longer offer sacrifice to any other god, but only to the LORD. Contrast this with the behavior of those who Jesus Himself cleanses. Only one returns to give thanks.

The word Eucharist means thanksgiving. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the greatest act of prayer that exists and one in which we primarily come not to gain something out of it, but rather to offer ourselves, our time in union with the One on the cross who cleanses us of our sin by His Blood. This weekend marks our second annual Forty Hours Devotion in which the Blessed Sacrament is solemnly exposed for two whole days. It is a great time of retreat for our parish where it is my ardent hope that we can all "slow down" together and come and spend some quiet time in the Lord's Presence to give thanks, to contemplate His Divine Presence among us, to ask for forgiveness, and to pray for one another. It is a time in which, just like Naaman the Syrian, many may doubt the power of God, but when we come to spend an hour in His Presence, He can transform us.

On another note, please spread the word to fellow parishioners and adorers about not only Forty Hours devotion, but also the addition of our 7:30am Sunday Mass!
