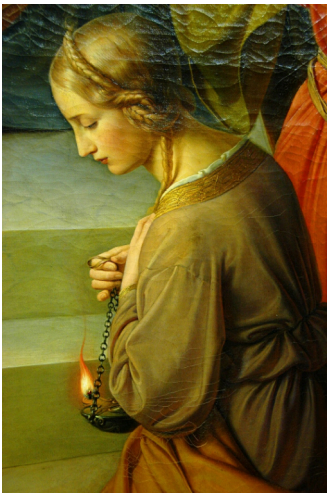

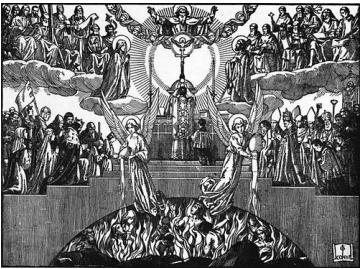
VIRTUE: CHARITY
