### FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

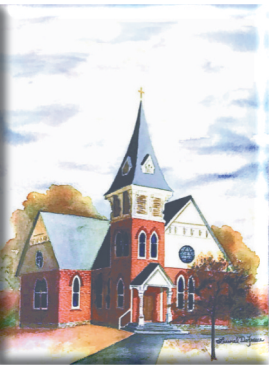
All are invited to celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on Dec.

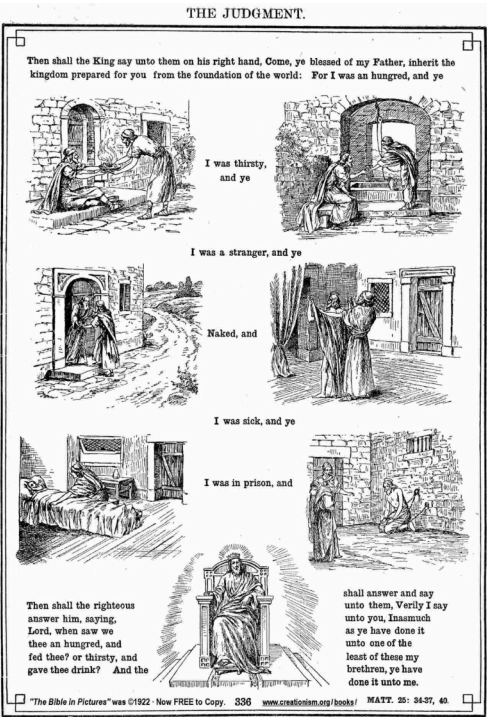

Happy Christ the King Sunday!! This Sunday caps the liturgical year. Pope Pius XI instituted this Feast on the last Sunday of October in 1925 as a means to recognize the Kingship of Christ in the here and now. While it is not celebrated on the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, we are reminded that Jesus is not only the King of our hearts, but our families, our towns, and our country as well. His reign flows through our laws, if they be just, and through our public behavior. We do not compartmentalize Christ.

One of the devotions that Pope Pius XI asked of the faithful is that on Christ the King Sunday, we would all make reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for all of the sins of the world and our own committed against Him. We would also ask for the graces of continued conversion for the world. This Sunday, after the 10am Mass, we will briefly expose the Blessed Sacrament, pray this prayer of reparation together, and receive Benediction. Happy Christ the King Sunday!

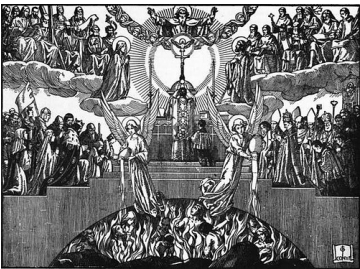
