

Dear Friends In Christ.

On this First Sunday of Advent and the peginning of a new liturgical year, we hear from St. Paul's Letter from the Romans—"Let us throw off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light; let us conduct ourselves properly as in the day." As a bookend, the Church offers us St. John's Prologue on the

Third Mass during the Day of Christmas which talks about the Light who is Christ Himself entering the world—"The light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it." How do we receive this Light that is to appear to us at Christmas? By preparing in a spirit of penance and sobriety. By voluntarily disciplining our appetites. This is what the Season of Advent is all about. Although the Church doesn't require any outward penance by Law during this season, it is largely up to us to make this gift to God of growth in holiness. For that reason, the Church asks us to refrain from the warmth of the organ at Mass and to undergo silence whenever possible, to not adorn the altar with flowers or symbols of joy. We must deprive our senses if we are going to live purely in the Light of Christ to come. We must dutifully prepare ourselves. What gift will we offer the Infant King this Advent? Let us prepare the way of the Lord to our hearts, sweep the way clean, to make a path for the Infant King.

## DE PROFUNDIS -PSALM 130

The psalmist is crying out here from the depression that grips him because of his sense of sin. He tells God that no man could be forgiven should strict justice be demanded; but, since God is forgiving and merciful, the psalmist (Israel) will hope for redemption from iniquities. We, who know the mercy of God far better than the Israelites, may pray this psalm with even greater trust in God. The Church uses this psalm in the liturgy as her official prayer for the souls in Purgatory.

Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord; Lord, hear my, voice! Let Your ears be attentive to my voice in supplication: If You, O Lord, mark iniquities, Lord, who can stand? But with You is forgiveness, that You may be revered. I trust in the Lord; my soul trusts in His word. My soul waits for the Lord more than sentinels wait for the dawn. More than sentinels wait for the dawn, let Israel wait for the Lord, For with the Lord is kindness and with Him is plenteous redemption; And He will redeem Israel from all their iniquities.
