Dear Friends in Christ,

The entrance antiphon for the Second Sunday of Advent proclaims: “People of Zion behold, the Lord is coming to save all nations; and the Lord shall cause you to hear his majestic voice for the joy of your heart.”

This Sunday, we begin to concentrate on the narrative of St. John the Baptist and his prophetic gestures concerning the coming of the Lord. Jesus calls the Baptist the greatest born of women. He is the threshold between the Old and New Covenants announcing the coming Messiah with a baptism of repentance. After having transitioned from eschatology in the First Sunday of Lent and the end of the liturgical year, we now turn ourselves towards the more imminent coming of the Lord in the flesh. To repent means to turn around from our former ways of life. It means to make a sound examination of where we are in life right now. Do we like who we are? It’s an honest question. The Lord comes into the world to reconcile us with the Father. As we edge closer to Christmas, we focus on penance this week to prepare our hearts for the Lord to enter.
