Dear Friends in Christ,

1. A Blessed Fourth Sunday of Advent to all of you. Thank you for your prayers as I recovered from my minor surgery. I really do appreciate it! Thank you to all who have helped with meals. Please welcome Fr. Nathan Rueb, Vocation Director, this weekend for 4pm Mass.

2. The Fourth Sunday of Advent gives us a hint of what is to come. In fact, we are able to experience Joseph's side of the story and experience his radical trust in God's revelation through a dream about the Divine Child that Mary is carrying in her virginal womb. Traditionally, we focus in this last week from December 17th until the 23rd at Vespers on the different titles of Christ in what are called the "O" antiphons (Root of Jesse, Key of David, etc.). It is a time of more intense preparation to arrive at Bethlehem to adore the Lord. In the midst of all of our familial preparation, let us not forget that Christ is among us and He awaits our visit at Christmas. As a reminder, the Christmas schedule is the following:
