Dear Friends In Christ.

Advent is a season of the liturgical year that makes us choose—between eternal life and eternal death. There is a threshold or a precipice on which we find ourselves when we encounter Christ every Second Sunday of Advent at the Iordan River. We have heard about the Lord who is to come in glory a second time and we apply this readiness to

receive Him spiritually as a child. This week, we focus on the theme of repentance or to be more exact, change. When St. John the Baptist preaches the coming of Christ, he preaches penance as a salutary means of clearing the way so that we can receive the Word Made Flesh when He comes to us and inaugurates the Kingdom of God. Christianity is a religion of being constantly prepared and ready. To apply this to the coming of the infant King at Bethlehem allows us now to meditate in this part of our Advent journey for how we will change. St. Paul last week lists all of the things we should rid ourselves of. Repentance is precisely this-conversion of heart. We cannot receive Jesus who is our salvation if we are mired in sin and sloth. We must not only be awake, as the Lord reminds us last week, but now we must prepare ourselves by clearing the "threshing floor" of the chaff of sin. It is in this way that we will receive the stream of grace that emanates from the crib.
