The Married Couples Retreat is an introduction to the Domestic Church Movement, a simple, beautiful gift of formation, support, and true, organic growth in love and faith within the Sacrament of Marriage. Couples may attend the retreat simply to benefit their relationship. Following the retreat they may join a monthly small group where they will receive support and formation to live out the 7 Commitments of the Domestic Church Movement, a set of simple and ordinary actions – lived in the family and home. This formation was developed by the founder, Servant of God, Fr. Blachnicki, under the direction of Archbishop Karol Wotyla (before he became Pope St. John Paul II). The commitments of this movement are principles that couples commit to live in their ordinary family life; things like praying daily as individuals, as a couple, and with their family. The movement provides formation, using the Church's spiritual tradition and official teachings, for how to pray, how to use Scripture in prayer, and how to grow in relationship with God, spouse, and children. The decisions about specific ways to do this are up to the family because they are a domestic church. There are a limited number of slots in our own parish groups to participate in monthly formation. 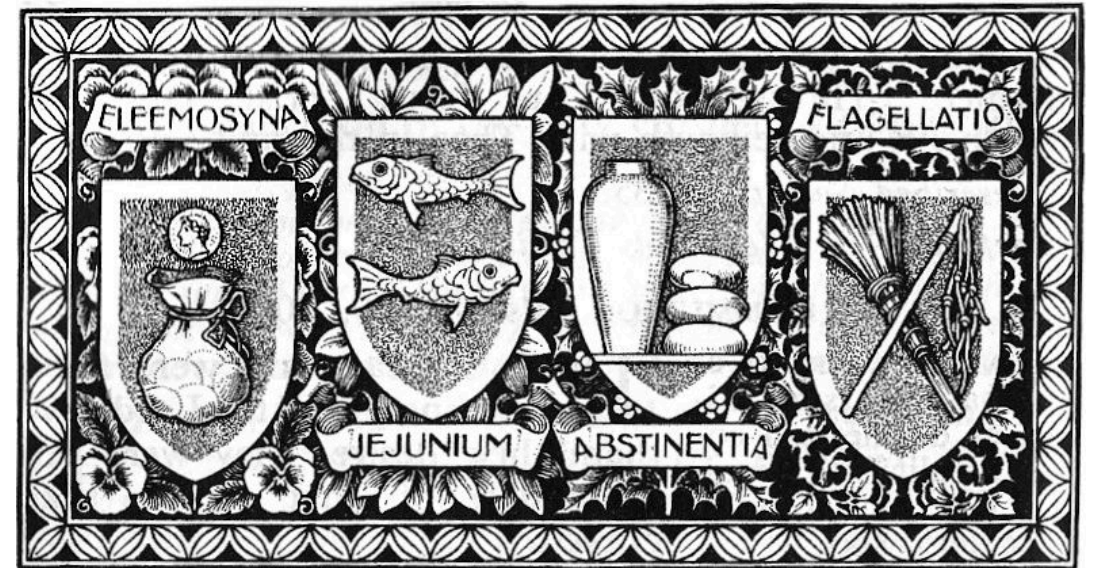

Dear Friends in Christ,

This week, we begin the Season of Quadragesima or Lent which means 40 days. We journey with the Lord for forty days in the desert of penance and fasting so that we might meet Him at the empty tomb. The journey of Lent comprises three “stool legs,” if you will, of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. The self-denial aspect of Lent disciplines our bodies so that we can concentrate more on the things of God and not the things of earth. This discipline enables us to pray better, to engross ourselves in the reading of the Scripture and spending time in silence. When we do this, we should be more charitable. By worshipping God, we become more like Him and desire to be more charitable to those around us in need. The last three days of readings in the Roman Breviary on Sunday through Tuesday of this week focus on the story of Abraham wherein God shows us the meaning of sacrifice and is a type of the Lord Himself mounting the cross.
