

Dear Friends in Christ,

Our Lord today enjoins us to let our "yes mean yes and our no mean no." In what was formerly Sexagesmia Sunday or sixty symbolic days before Lent, we can meditate on what today's Gospel from Matthew means with the original theme that comes from the former preparation for Lent. In the ancient Gospel for this Sunday, we heard the parable of the sower; how the

sower goes out to sow and sprinkles seed on various weather and ground conditions only to have the one that is well-rooted take shape and bear fruit. When we make a profession of Faith, does our yes to salvation mean yes and our no to evil, no? A lot of the fruitfulness that can come about from Lenten practice means that we must till the soil of our hearts right now. We must prepare for what is coming. If we are lukewarm in our decisions to follow Christ, we cannot expect some miracle to take place. By habituating ourselves right now in virtue, by examining our consciences now and asking ourselves where our "yes" has been maybe or our "no" to sin a compromise with a "yes," we can see where God is calling us to grow, where He is calling us to put aside our former ways and where He is calling us to restoration where we are wounded. As we have one and a half weeks before Ash Wednesday, we reflect in the here and now, not later, in how Jesus Christ is asking us to conform ourselves to Him with a resounding and complete "yes" of the

heart and mind. -Fr. Schneider


