MARRIED COUPLES DOMESTIC CHURCH INTRODUCTORY RETREAT AT HOLY TRINITY PARISH IN WESTON April 19-21, 2024

The Married Couples Retreat is an introduction to the Domestic Church Movement, a simple, beautiful gift of formation, support, and true, organic growth in love and faith within the Sacrament of Marriage. Couples may attend the retreat simply to benefit their relationship. Following the retreat they may join a monthly small group where they will receive support and formation to live out the 7 Commitments of the Domestic Church Movement, a set of simple and ordinary actions – lived in the family and home. This formation was developed by the founder, Servant of God, Fr. Blachnicki, under the direction of Archbishop Karol Wotyla (before he became Pope St. John Paul II). The commitments of this movement are principles that couples commit to live in their ordinary family life; things like praying daily as individuals, as a couple, and with their family. The movement provides formation, using the Church's spiritual tradition and official teachings, for how to pray, how to use Scripture in prayer, and how to grow in relationship with God, spouse, and children. The decisions about specific ways to do this are up to the family because they are a domestic church. There are a limited number of slots in our own parish groups to participate in monthly formation. Dear Friends in Christ,

On this First Sunday of Lent, we enter into what was formerly called the “caput ieunii” or head of the great fast. And every First Sunday of Lent, we always here the story of the Lord’s Temptation in the Desert. There are many spiritual explanations for this, but perhaps one that is fitting for this article is this—we much understand the nature of sin and temptation before we can fight it ourselves with the grace of God. We must understand what the devil is after. And we can clearly see this in what he proposes to the Lord—bodily and fleshly desires, desires for power in the will and a desire to even throw away one’s life as if it is not a gift from the Father. Ultimately, the last one tells us a lot about who Satan is—He has always been a murderer from the beginning as the Lord Himself says. Satan wants us to die. The Christian paradox that is proposed to us in Lent is that by willingly choosing to kill our own ego and our own fleshly desires born of concupiscence, we find freedom in Life Itself who is Christ.

I would like to welcome members of the St. Mary’s Home for Mothers to Mass today and to speak after Mass in the coffee hall about how we can support this very important apostolate in our diocese to assist mothers in need. Happy Lent!
