

Dear Friends in Christ, This Wednesday begins the solemn season of our annual Lenten observance in which we accompany the Lord Jesus through the desert and confront what is evil in us so that we may be renewed with the grace of the resurrection. Since the Middle Äges, we have split up the season in various ways in order that we might delve more deeply into the mystery. The first

few days of Lent were a later addition so that the total (minus Sundays) would add up to a complete forty days of penance. Symbolically, the first four weeks also account for the forty days while the last two weeks of Lent (the Fifth Week and Holy Week) accounted for Passiontide where we have an increased attention to the Passion of the Lord.

As we set out to journey with the Lord, Lent is a journey of spiritual renewal; it is a denial of bodily pleasure, bodily goods that we may be "re-ordered" to be like the Risen Christ. Because of our concupiscence or our tendency to sin as well as our sins themselves, it is necessary that we take on ascetical habits in an increased way in order to re-order our actions to what is in accord with right reason as expressed in not only the Ten Commandments, but the teachings of Christ. Self-denial and purposeful and deliberate restraint of our desires curtails the impulse to act as our emotional life tells us to act. To the contrary, these penances are supposed to order us to once again think and act according to eternal truths. We are both body and soul; for this reason, we cannot merely have a "good intention," but must actually do something different. Habitual action shapes our thinking. Our thinking or belief about someone or something should translate into what we do.

As we approach this sacred season, please check the Lenten schedule in the bulletin for Mass time changes (Ash Wednesday) as well as for our events.


