Dear Friends in Christ,

In the Gospel of Matthew this First Sunday of Lent, we encounter the classic theme of the Lord going out into the desert to confront the devil. Theologically speaking, this is what is called an “external temptation.” In His perfect humanity, Jesus is not interiorly tempted to actually do what the devil is asking Him to do.

What the Lord is doing is vanquishing and conquering these temptations that are common to all of us—to rely on human means to feed our soul; to sin in order to gain power; to forgo the worship of God for idols in our lives. By Christ’s three-fold rejection of these temptations, He conquers death and sin for us and reverses the curse from Original Sin.

We confront these same lies in our own souls. We know that they are untrue, yet how often do we fall into them? During this Lent, as we follow the path of self-denial, we acquiesce our doubt, our fear into the hands of God’s Providence. May He give us the grace to trust Him.

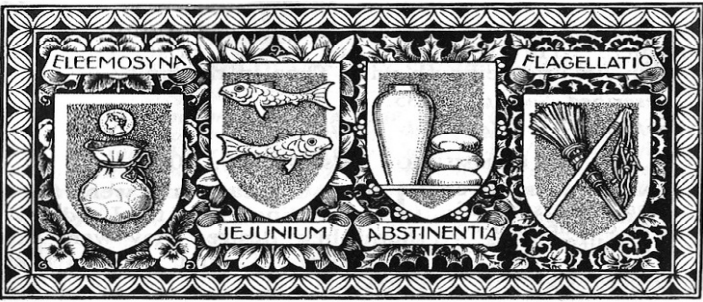
