

Dear Friends in Christ,

We are two and a half weeks from the Lenten Season!! Formerly, in the ancient Roman Calendar, this Sunday began the season of Septuagesima wherein we began seventy symbolic days before the Resurrection of Ćhrist. With the Christmas cycle ending on February 2^{nd} with Candlemas, we now turn our

attention to preparing for the Resurrection. In the ancient lectionary cycle, we hear from St. Paul's letter from the Corinthians wherein he posits to us a challenge by his own sacred words—Know you not that they that run in the race, all run indeed, but one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain. And everyone that strives for the mastery refrains himself from all things: and they indeed that they may receive a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible one. I therefore so run, not as at an uncertainty; I so fight, not as one beating the air; but I chastise my body, and bring it into subjection.." What will we refrain from this Lenten Season? What do we need to lav aside to be refreshed in the Lord? What spiritual "principalities" are we battling as St. Paul would say. We begin pondering these things today. Lent is nigh; let us prepare worthily for spiritual renewal!
