The Married Couples Retreat is an introduction to the Domestic Church Movement, a simple, beautiful gift of formation, support, and true, organic growth in love and faith within the Sacrament of Marriage. Couples may attend the retreat simply to benefit their relationship. Following the retreat they may join a monthly small group where they will receive support and formation to live out the 7 Commitments of the Domestic Church Movement, a set of simple and ordinary actions – lived in the family and home. This formation was developed by the founder, Servant of God, Fr. Blachnicki, under the direction of Archbishop Karol Wotyla (before he became Pope St. John Paul II). The commitments of this movement are principles that couples commit to live in their ordinary family life; things like praying daily as

individuals, as a couple, and with their family. The movement provides formation, using the Church's spiritual tradition and official teachings, for how to pray, how to use Scripture in prayer, and how to grow in relationship with God, spouse, and children. The decisions about specific ways to do this are up to the family because they are a domestic church. There are a limited number of slots in our own parish groups to

As we make our way through the Lenten journey, we are reminded of the traditional themes for each of these Sundays. While the First and Second Sunday of Lent always have the Temptation in the Desert and the

Transfiguration respectively, the Third Sunday changes from year to year. In the Ancient Lectionary of the Church, this Sunday had Jesus casting out a demon from a mute man only to be accused and questioned by what authority He had done so. Although we hear about the Lord in this Gospel driving the money changers from the Temple, I think we can ask the same question—by what authority can He do and say these things? By what authority can He use His very hand to drive out demons and those who use Divine Revelation for their own benefit and glory? This drives at the second point—why do we not believe Jesus of Nazareth can change us? He has overcome temptation for us, showed us what He will do for us individually by His own death and resurrection and thirdly, He shows us His Power even over evil and sin and death. Something to ponder this Lent as we head into the half-way point next weekend—do I believe that Jesus can unmute my heart? Will I let Him and invite Him to drive away the "money-changers' that exist in my conscience to excuse myself or be used? Jesus says that He will raise this Temple in three days after it is destroyed— He speaks of the Temple of His Body. Will He not do the same for us if we welcome Him?
