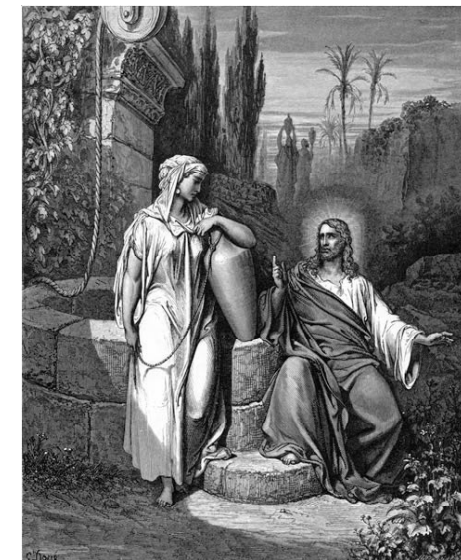

Dear Friends in Christ,

“Is the LORD in our midst, or not?” This is the question that the Israelites pose to one another in their frustration with Moses in the desert. It is a question that we, too pose to ourselves in the midst of the desert of life. The story ends with Moses striking the rock and water flowing forth for the Israelites to drink even after they doubted God.

Fast forward to the Lord encountering the Samaritan woman at the well who had given up on herself. She no longer really believed in anything or anyone at all. She knew the customs of Samaritans and Jews, her state in life as being considered unclean for her lifestyle and was at the well when no one else was there to simply draw water privately. This is where the Lord encounters her. He tells her that He will provide for her “living water.” When we are thirsty spiritually, it is not enough to try and re-hydrate the body with old methods that do not work while neglecting one’s spiritual dehydration. Lent is about an encounter with the Lord in the midst of our own sinfulness and brokenness. Where am I broken? Where is Jesus in all of this? What are my sins of which I’m unwilling to let go? We encounter Jesus at the well. He tells us all that we’ve ever done because He knows us better than we know ourselves. There is freedom in that. Initially, it is a scary thing. When we overcome this fear and begin to trust God more than ourselves, we find living water.

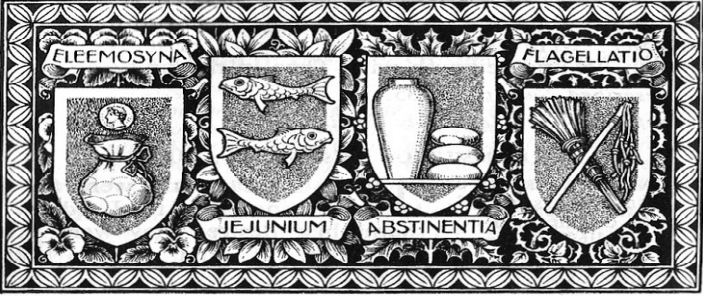
