This Sunday, we celebrate Laetare Sunday in which the Church causes us to rejoice even in the midst of Lent at the coming of the Glorious Resurrection of the Lord. For this reason, we are permitted to utilize the organ on its own as normal, to have flowers on the altar, and to wear the rose-colored vestments to signal this Sunday of joy. We have made it half-way through Lent! After this Sunday, we will have only four more Sundays in the church building before we migrate to the hall for several months while our restoration takes place. 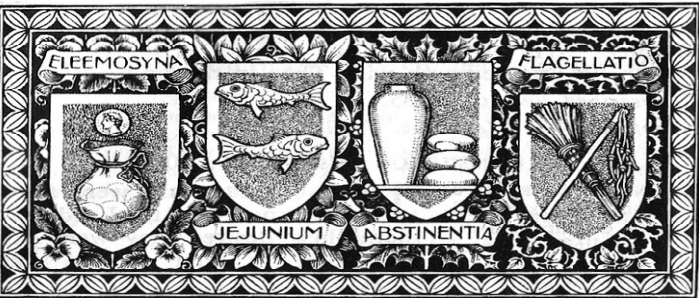
