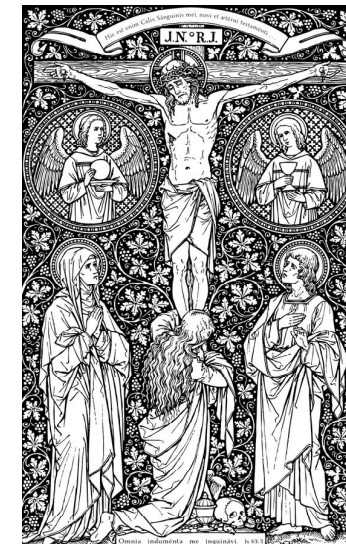

Dear Friends in Christ,

In the readings towards the end of Lent, we tend to focus on two things—the resuscitation miracles as well as Our Lord getting persecuted violently, but not yet having “His time come.” In hearing about the stories of the Widow at Nain’s son earlier this week as well as the resuscitation of Lazarus from the dead, we get a glimpse of one of the aspects of the glorious resurrection that Our Lord will fulfill on Easter. By raising people from the dead, the Lord shows that He not only has power over the fallen world, but principally, He has power over death itself. While these men whom the Lord resuscitated would eventually die a natural death, the difference between these miracles and the resurrection is that the glory of the resurrection ensures that we never die.

These last two weeks of Lent were traditionally subdivided as “Passiontide.” The original Gospel for this Sunday has Christ almost getting stoned for asserting that He is the God of Israel, but He hides Himself until it is time for the Passion. We, too “hide” the images of the saints and the image of Christ Himself crucified during this period. In a way, it is almost a fasting of the senses. We are deprived of looking at the images of the saints glorified in Heaven and the Risen Lord in His Sacred Heart until we celebrate the Easter Vigil. The image of the Crucified Lord is unveiled on Good Friday where we will have the opportunity to venerate the image. “By His stripes, we are healed” says Isaiah the Prophet. As we delve further into the mystery at hand, we yearn and wait for the time where we can see what the Lord has done for us and we experience the glory of His Resurrected Body on Easter.

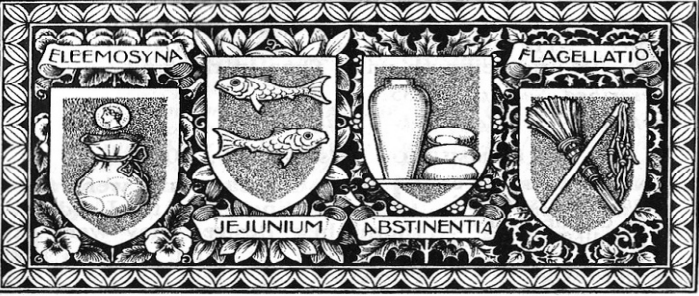
