The Second Sunday of Lent, much like the First Sunday of Lent, always has the same theme every year. The Second Sunday of Lent's Gospel "theme," if you will, is the Transfiguration of the Lord. In the Traditional Calendar of the Church, we have just embarked on our Lenten journey. The Ember Days of Lent (Wednesday, Friday

and Saturday) were celebrated last week which are days of extra penance for the clergy and the Church. Now, after we've began our journey we are refreshed in the hope of the resurrection of the Lord by witnessing this extraordinary even on Mt. Tabor. One of the effects of the glorious resurrection is claritas or a light which shines through the body. In this episode, the Lord takes Peter, James and John up a mountain and they get a glimpse of this Divine Light. Our Lord shows them, although they have no understanding of what they just witnessed, what He will do on Easter Sunday. The Light of God literally shines through the Lord's earthly flesh. We can call the Word made Flesh truly the Splendor of the Father.

The Second Sunday of Lent rightly gives us the spiritual hope that we so desire and that we need to be good Christians. We must remember why we do the penances that we do. They are not for naught, but by denying the body its perceived needs and wants, we attain a more supernatural outlook and a more virtuous life. The mysterious event that takes place on Mt. Tabor is a reminder that the Resurrection of the Lord is only five short weeks away. Where will we build a place for Him to reign in our souls?


