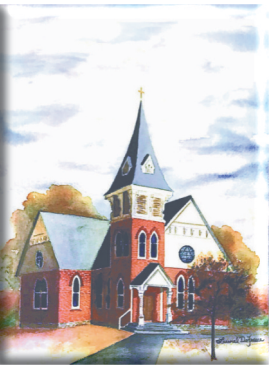
LAWN MOWING TEAM

Dear Friends in Christ,

The disciples knew Jesus in the “breaking of the Bread.” This classical term for the Eucharist is not symbolic. In fact, at the Roman Mass, the consecrated Host is still fractured coming from the

words in Latin, “fractio panis” or the Breaking of the Bread and a piece of the Consecrated Host is placed in the chalice which represents the Resurrection of the Lord or the re-joining of His Sacred Body and Blood after His bloody crucifixion. Indeed, we as Christians receive the RISEN Body and Blood of the Lord in Holy Communion. We who are present at Holy Mass recognize the Risen Lord in the same way by this perpetual memorial of His Death and His making Himself present in this Eucharistic way among us. When He says to us, “Behold, I am with you always until the end of the age,” indeed He is—Present among us in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Next weekend at 10am Mass, our parish family will celebrate the First Holy Communion of 9 of our young people. Congratulations to them and their families and thank you to their parents and teacher.

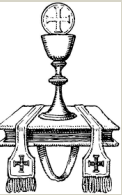
SOUL of Christ, sanctify me.
