Dear Friends in Christ,

We have begun our journey together to restore our beautiful church! A very heartfelt thank you to those who helped set up on Sunday and to all of those who came and spent the day on Monday helping to ready the church! I am grateful

and proud of all of our parishioners coming together as a team and a family to care for our parish.

As we look back on the mystery of the Resurrection almost two weeks out, we can forget that Paschaltide is actually 50 days. Easter is not a "one-and-done" event. The Paschal Candle reminds us of Christ's Risen Presence all the way until His Glorious Ascension. The Gospel of Emmaus reminds us of our inability to trust in Christ. Our Lord upbraids His disciples for their disbelief in His resurrection. Just because they haven't encountered Him yet, they immediately stopped believing. It is not until they experience the Lord's Eucharistic Presence that they realize it was Him and desire to have Him come into their hearts even more. When we are in the Lord's Eucharistic Presence, this is the attitude we should have. An attitude of longing to spend more time with Him, and attitude where we ask Him to stay with us. Indeed, evening approaches, but the Light of the World is among us!
