PLATTSBURG NURSING HOME APOSTOLATE

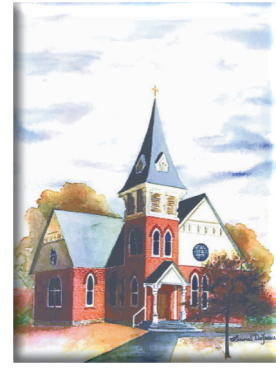

Dear Friends in Christ,

“If you remain in me, and my words remain in you...” Last weekend, we celebrated our First Holy Communion Mass. Congratulations to our children on the reception of this sacrament once again.

This month of April, dedicated to the Blessed Sacrament, gives us an impetus to think about the Lord's Presence from the above text. How do we “remain in the Lord?” When we receive Holy Communion, the Lord is physically present in our own bodies, if but for a few minutes. This is precious time spent to really enter into union with Him. He makes us like Himself when we receive Him worthily. We can literally be no closer to Him than in that moment. After Mass, it is customary to even make a short thanksgiving before we leave the Church to thank the Lord for what He has done for us. We can also offer the merits of our own Holy Communion as an offering for people in our own lives who need our prayers. Let us spend time with the Eucharistic Lord this coming week in Adoration so that His Word and His Flesh and Blood may truly abide in us.

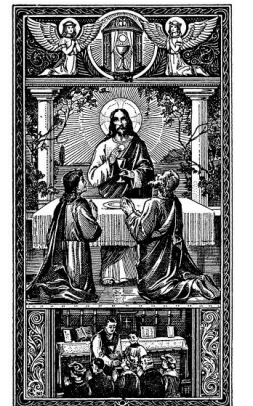
