Dear Friends in Christ,

On this Sunday, we meditate upon the image of the Good Shepherd. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, is one of the oldest images in Christianity and it comes from this chapter of St. John. If we were to read on this year for the next few verses, we would see the Lord Himself declare this. When Our Lord is speaking here, He talks of thieves, and robbers who “steal, slaughter, and destroy.” This is precisely the opposite of how God is. If we were to define the word “antichrist,” one could say that the description that Jesus gives would fit right in—an antichrist robs faith, then tries to further the damage by destroying the body and finally, attempts to annihilate completely any sort of fruit. Our Lord gives the virtue of Faith; He heals and builds up the body, and then He proliferates His graces that His Mystical Body might grow. Jesus came to give us life and life abundantly. As we receive His Risen and Glorified Flesh and Blood, let us contemplate this mystery of the Good Shepherd who feeds us.
