Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday, we celebrate Dominica in Albis so-called because the recently baptized in the ancient church would put aside their white albs or baptismal albs that they had worn all week.

St. John Paul II also named this Sunday Divine Mercy Sunday in which, under the usual conditions, we have the opportunity for a Plenary Indulgence. We will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet together after the 10am Mass. As we accompany the “Doubting Thomas” to the upper room where the Risen Lord appears once again, we have the opportunity to reflect upon our own doubt. We see this recorded as well in the Gospel of Matthew where the text states that at Jesus’ Ascension, “they worshipped Him, but some doubted.” Why is it that we doubt after we have seen Him, experienced Him? The Lord is Risen, He gives Himself to us in the Most Blessed Sacrament, and He promises to return in all of His glory again. For now, we await His glorious return, we ask Him to remove the doubts that we have in our own lives, and to exclaim with St. Thomas, “My Lord, and My God.”
