Dear Friends in Christ,
The Lord is Risen! He is Risen indeed! A very Blessed Easter to all of you! As we celebrate the resurrection of the Lord, we are filled with hope in the Light of the World’s victory over darkness, sin and death. By His glorious resurrection the Risen Lord destroys sin and death forever. We participate in this victory by our baptism. This year, we were privileged to welcome into the Catholic Church Nicholas Adams who was baptized and confirmed at the Easter Vigil Mass.
The Risen Lord teaches us by His resurrection how our own will be. The resurrection of the body and life everlasting is one of the least understood teachings of Christianity. Because we are both body and soul, our soul’s natural place is the body. Each soul is made unique by the body it animates. A human being is a body and soul composite. We neither souls trapped in a body, nor a body with no soul. We are both. When the soul leaves the body, it is true that we are dead, but our soul is immortal. It is a spiritual principal that is not destroyed. It is also true that because of Original Sin, our bodies do not live on forever. Baptism, however, gives us this eternal life and the promise of the resurrection. Matter cannot be destroyed. The final judgment and glorious resurrection when time ceases mean that our soul will be reunited with our glorified body. Our bodies will be like that of Christ Himself. We will no longer be subject to time, space, pain or sickness or sin. When we live the cross in our lives now, our wounds are made glorious. The instrument of pain and death becomes the path to eternal life and the symbol of victory over death itself. As we worthily receive the Risen Body of the Lord, we assimilate His Flesh and Blood into our very own that we might, too become like the Savior. Indeed, Christ our Paschal Victim is sacrificed. Alleluia.
