Dear Friends in Christ,

Happy Mother's Day! Today, we ask God's blessing on all of the mothers in our parish family that He might give them the grace to fulfill their state in life. We thank you for the gift of your motherhood. May the Blessed Virgin Mary, Our Mother, protect you and your families.

This Sunday marks the last Sunday before the Ascension of the Lord. The Sacred Scriptures tell us that the Lord ascended into Heaven out of the sight of the Apostles forty days after His Resurrection (Thursday). In the United States, in most locales, this has been transferred to the following Sunday and is unfortunately no longer a Holy Day of Obligation. Nonetheless, as we prepare for this short Season of the Ascension, a sort of sub-season within Paschaltide, we hear from the Gospel of John once again wherein Our Lord tells His Apostles that soon, the world will not see Him anymore, but that they will. He says that He will "not leave them orphans." Ascension Thursday is a sort of bookend to Holy Thursday when the Lord gives us His Presence in the Most Holy Eucharist. It is in this way that He doesn't abandon us, but remains with us in His Eucharistic Form, risen and ascended, outside of time and space, enabling His Resurrected Flesh and Blood to be present on each and every altar of the world. Jesus shows us the Father. The Father does not abandon His children. The Word of God made flesh, the Splendor of the Father, as Good Shepherd is always faithful. For now, we wait with anticipation to journey with Our Lord in these last days of Paschaltide, to see Him disappear from our midst, but yet remain present among us in a new way.
