

Dear Friends in Christ,

Foday, we celebrate one of the most solemn feasts of the year–Pentecost! We ask in a particular way for the Holy Spirit to descend upon our hearts and minds to re-order us in Christ. In some of the Masses of the year, the Church gives us what is called a Sequence or a

medieval poem which was originally an elongation of the letter "a" of the word Alleluia. It was a poetic way of elongating the word which means "Praise the Lord" in Hebrew to meditate on the theme of the day. In this Sequence entitled Veni, Sancte Spiritus, we ask the Holy Spirit to warm what is cold and bend what is rigid. Where are those places in the recesses of our souls where we have become cold and un-Christ-like to others? We need to ask the Holy Spirit to descend upon us to make us see as He sees with His Seven-Fold Gift. The Holy Spirit will make us like the Risen Christ, He will illumine us, and re-create us in His Image. Traditionally, the Feast of Pentecost had an accompanying octave where we would meditate on an aspect of His Appearance for seven days. We are invited to meditate on this theme this week. Each day, we ask for one of His Gifts–Knowledge, Understanding, Piety, Counsel, Wisdom, Fortitude, Fear of the Lord.
