Dear Friends in Christ,

This week, on Friday, we begin the Holy Spirit Novena. The prayers are included on the back of the bulletin along with the consecration prayer and prayer for the Seven Gifts. The Apostles and the

Blessed Mother waited for nine days after the Lord's Ascension for the Holy Spirit to manifest Himself at Pentecost. This is the first "novena" of the Church. Also, located in the bulletin and the back of the church is literature on 'The Way,' Bishop Johnston's catechesis initiative that we will be implementing for our youth.

This Thursday is the traditional day on which on Lord ascends into Heaven. Just as we spent 40 days in the desert with the Lord, He is among His Apostles in His Risen Presence for 40 days before being taken out of their sight. While we celebrate this in the United States on Sunday, it is nevertheless a time in which we contemplate what the Lord does for our bodies. Just as He takes up His Own Flesh made glorious in the sight of the Father, He promises to do the same for us. And although He is no longer present among us in a natural mode, He leaves us His complete and total substance in His Eucharistic Presence. He does not abandon us!
