

#### Dear Friends in Christ.



've had people ask me before, "Are deacons new in the Church?" Many are surprised to learn that all priests are ordained deacons before being ordained priests. There are also no such thing as "lay deacons." When people say this, what they are referring to is the permanent diaconate who,

in the United States, usually consists of married men. There are several categories of Tradition in the Catholic Church which are delineated by their origin. There is Dominical Tradition or Sacred Tradition that comes from the mouth of the Lord which is not written in the Scriptures. We also have Divino-Apostolic Tradition which is established by the Apostles in the time of Public Revelation from God

which ended at the death of the Last Apostle, St. John. This Tradition is inspired by the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity. We witness this today in the Acts of the Apostles at the ordination of the first deacons. By the laying on of hands and the invocation of the Holy Spirit, these men are given a sacred character and the lowest rank of Holy Orders which conforms them to Christ the Servant. The order of deacon is to serve at the altar and assist the priest with preparing the gifts for the sacrificial offering of the Mass, and also to proclaim the Cospel and in a limited way, has a catechetical mandate. In the early Church and up through the middle ages, deacons who were always celibate or if married, continent, administered the temporal goods of the Church and cared for widows, orphans and the poor. St. Francis of Assisi was actually a deacon; he was never ordained to the priesthood. As we progress through May, Bishop Johnston will ordain one transitional deacon this year on Saturday, May 20th at the Cathedral of St. Joseph. Let us pray for his ministry as the Lord bestows upon him the gift of Holy Orders.
