

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday, we celebrate the translated feast of Corpus Christi, which on the General Roman Calendar, falls on Thursday. In the Middle Ages in the $13^{
m th}$ century when this feast came into being, very few people received Holy Communion due to local law. One of the ways,

through influence of the Holy Spirit, is that the people desired to worship the Eucharist and see it. St. Thomas Aquinas himself composed the sequence or poetic elongation of the "a" of the Alleluia of this Mass. Corpus Christi, because the actual day is Thursday, is kind of a joyful repeat of Holy Thursday which is tinged with the sorrow that comes with the Lord's Passion and Death. On Corpus Christi, we celebrate the principal truth of our Faith-the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament. In order to show a public manifestation of this truth, processions with an ostensorium or monstrance (both of which come from the word in Latin "to show") were a devotional way to expose the Blessed Sacrament and to adore the Presence of Christ. Indeed, the Cathedral of St. Joseph will hold one at which we are all invited to participate (Saturday night June 10). As we adore the Blessed Sacrament and profess our faith in His Real Presence, we are reminded that the Eucharist is NOT a symbol, but is Iesus Christ Himself who we confess to be the Lord of the Universe.
