Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel we hear about the parable of the Mustard seed of Faith. St. Paul exhorts us that "we walk by Faith and not by sight." Does that mean that faith is blind? No. Faith isn't sight either; this would require no assent of the will to a higher authority, but just a trust in ourselves. We need the virtue of faith while we are on this earth to attend ultimate union with God where all things will be revealed. While supernatural faith has its origin in God Himself and cannot be strictly merited, we must cooperate with what has been given to us. The mustard seed that is planted into our souls at baptism is harvested and grows into a large tree if we live accordingly.

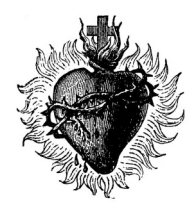

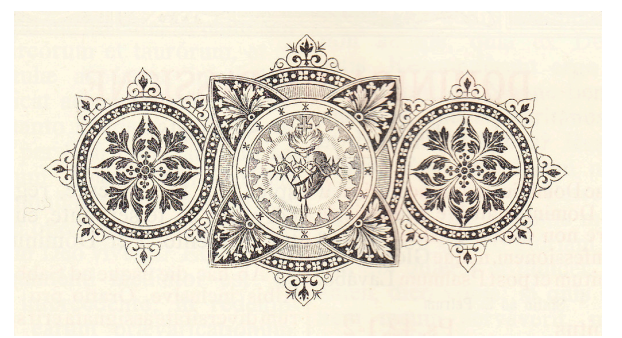
