Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Corpus Christi Sunday, the Church gives us the gift of contemplating His Divine Presence in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Corpus Christi is technically on a Thursday in the General Roman Calendar, although throughout the world, it is typically celebrated on Sunday externally. Thursday, however, is an important day because it is the day on which Our Lord instituted the Eucharist. Because Holy Thursday is so closely tied with the Passion of the Lord, it is fitting that we meditate upon Christ’s Risen Presence among us in Itself. This Wednesday, after the evening Mass, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until Thursday morning with Benediction. Friday morning, there will be no Mass, but we will have Low Mass with organ on Friday night at 6:00pm followed by exposition, the Litany of the Sacred Heart, the re-consecration of our parish family to the Sacred Heart and prayers of reparation followed by Benediction.

After 10:00am Mass this weekend, weather permitting, we will process around the church building to two Benediction stations and complete our ceremony with Benediction a third time on the main altar.

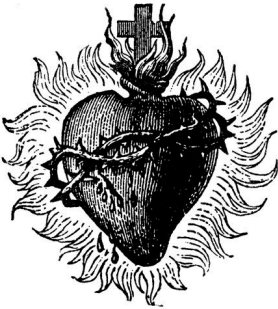
CATHOLIC MONTH OF JUNE

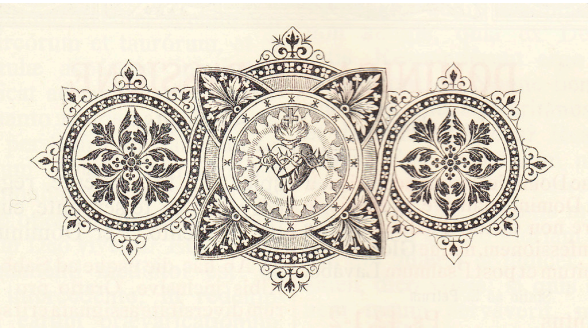
