Dear Friends in Christ,

When St. Paul is writing to the Romans, he tells them that the “gift is not like the transgression.” The transgression of which he speaks is the sin of Adam which is born of selfishness, self-centeredness and a sort of cowardliness (just think of Adam realizing he is naked and hiding from God). The self-gift of Christ on the cross is pure generosity. Jesus does not count the cost of His own Blood. Why does St. Paul remind the Romans about this? Because we project our own weakness onto God, our own infidelities, our own lack of commitment out of fear of having to give something of ourselves or that something will be taken away. God is not like this. God desires us. He wills our salvation. We only need to acquiesce to His grace freely offered and given to us. The gift of Christ is not like the transgression.

This Saturday, June 24th, marks the Solemnity of the Birth of St. John the Baptist. It is the only “Birthday” of a saint that we celebrate besides the Lord’s Nativity and His Blessed Mother as most “birthdays” are considered the saint’s birth into eternal life. Around Christmas or the winter solstice the days begin to get longer. From around the summer solstice, however, the days will get shorter—which gives a providential meaning to St. John’s words concerning his own role in reference to Christ in salvation history, “He must increase, I must decrease.” When we experience this relationship between Christ and the Baptist in the liturgical calendar, it is a reminder that the Gospel is imprinted upon the cosmos.

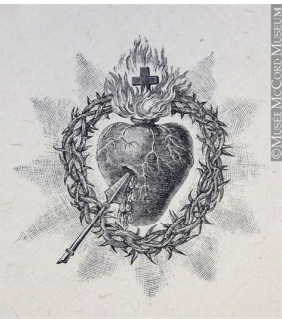
