



Dear Friends in Christ,

A blessed Trinity Sunday to all of you! As Paschaltide culminated with the Feast of Pentecost and the birth of the Church, we come to look simply at the mystery of who God is today. It makes perfect sense if one thinks about it. As we attribute humanly

various actions in salvation history to individual Persons of the Trinity, we now get a chance to see the Blessed Trinity as an undivided unity. While each person is distinct, all of the persons work together in one another. What we are really describing is a series of relations. When we say that we are made in the image and likeness of God, the classic Augustinian interpretation is that we have an intellect, a will and the relationship between the two. St. Bonaventure would argue that all of creation is stamped with a sort of image of the Blessed Trinity. Even marriage is an analogy—two distinct persons and the bond between them. Today, we praise God—Father, Son and Holy Spirit, who is Eternal and who has poured forth His Grace that we might have union with Him.
