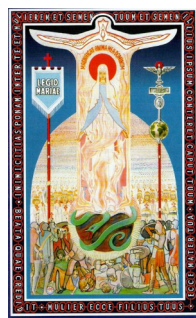

Dear Friends in Christ,

On this Sunday, we hear the parable of the weeds and the wheat which can be confounding. Why do we have to suffer evil in the world?
