Greetings from Fr. Drew,

The month of July is traditionally dedicated to Christ’s Precious Blood, a devotion as old as Christianity. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pope Pius IX, a year when murderous anti-Catholic revolutionists had taken over Rome. Pope Pius, disguised as a simple priest, riding on the back of a coach, barely escaped with his life. He left Rome, not to return for about a year. It was while Pius was absent from Rome that he made the feast of the Precious Blood, celebrated traditionally on July 1, the date the siege of Rome ended in 1849. The feast of the Precious Blood was suppressed in 1969.

The feast can now be celebrated as an optional Votive Mass, which can be said on certain liturgical days, when no other major feast is celebrated. I have a blood-red chasuble (outer garment for Mass) that I wear sometimes on martyrs’ feast days and the feast of the Precious Blood. You will notice during our Offertory and Eucharistic Prayer that on the back of it there is an embroidered gold chalice. Gazing on the chalice will help you enter into the sacred mystery of the Precious Blood.

I look forward to meeting everyone!


